ABOUT THE EXAMINATION

The Examination in Interventional Techniques. It will consist of three parts. Part 1 will be a theoretical examination. Part 2 will be identification of anatomical structures, equipment and x-ray equipment (C-arm). Part 3A will be a practical examination. Part 3B will be an oral examination.

For the practical examination, two examiners from a pool of about 30 examiners will evaluate each candidate. Examiners who are known intimately by the candidate shall not evaluate candidates.

Successful completion of FIPP with satisfy requirements for American Board of Interventional Pain Physicians (ABIPP) part II examination.

NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY

WIP does not discriminate against any person on the basis of age, gender, sexual orientation, race, religion, national origin, medical condition, physical disability, or marital status.

APPLYING TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION

You must complete the application form that you can receive by contacting Paula Brashear and submit all required documentation to apply for the examination.

It is very important that your application form be completed carefully and accurately. The information you provide in the application and any accompanying documents required will be used by WIP-Section of Pain Practice to determine your eligibility to sit for the examination.

The eligibility of candidates for this examination is that they should be boarded in the ABMS recognized specialty and have taken an added qualifications of ABA Pain Management, American Board of Interventional Pain Physicians (ABIPP) Part I, or the ABPM. From now on, we also consider candidates who will take the first Part of American Board of Interventional Pain Practice exam. ABIPP does not consider ABPM to satisfy Part I requirements.
